Important DMV Information for Basic Rider Course Students

Note: Rules and procedures are subject to change at DMV's discretion/ Information verified by actual site visit (Sheboygan DMV) on 12/08/14

1. Computer Knowledge Test Appointment Requirement:

NONE – walk-in status at all WI DMV sites. However, you must be at the site no less than 45 minutes before closing in order to take the test. Tell the DMV if you possess a waiver from the MSF course.

2. Cost of the DMV Computer Touch Screen Knowledge Test after BRC Completion:

NO CHARGE (Offered in English & Spanish via computer – tests in written form *may* be available in other languages)

3. Variations of DMV 25-Question CYCLE Knowledge Test:

Randomly selected by the computer; no double testing in a single day – must wait until next day to take the test again.

4. Number of Times Permitted to Take DMV Knowledge Test:

Maximum of **five** times – **80%** score required to pass (**five** incorrect permitted; if **six** incorrect, computer terminates the test with the sixth incorrect answer as a 'failure'). Additional attempts (beyond the five times allowed) require waiting one full year from date of first attempt.

5. Cost of Endorsement:

Between \$13 - \$85, depending on a variety of factors. For example, when you're regular DL expires, other endorsements (i.e. CDL), etc., therefore, bring sufficient funds. No TIP fee collected if you are presenting a waiver.

6. Methods of Payment:

The preferred payment is cash or check; the DMV will accept certain (but not all) credit cards – NO DEBIT cards please – check for posted information about which cards are accepted. However, ATM's exist at/near all DMV sites. Use of any credit card will include a 1.7% service fee added to the charge.

7. Study Materials:

Wisconsin Motorcyclists' Handbook available at DMV locations upon request or it can be downloaded at http://www.dot.state.wi.us/ Caution: The downloaded handbook is a large file 2.8 MB – which could cause a lengthy download time! Give yourself 20-30 minutes to review the Wisconsin Motorcyclists' Handbook prior to taking their Computer Knowledge Test. On average, about 90% of those who have read the Handbook and completed an MSF course pass the Computer Knowledge Test.

8. Remember:

Your **MV3575** *Motorcycle Waiver Form* is only valid for <u>one year</u> from the course completion date stated on the form!

9. DL Photo:

You will need to pose for a new/updated photo. You will be given an 'endorsement letter' that serves as your new, legal M-class endorsement; actual DL mailed to you in 7-10 business days.
