



Thank you for registering to participate in the Salute to Cycle touring session during the MotoAmerica Series presents the Dunlop Championship at Road America.

The advance price is \$25 per person-not per bike.

To ensure you are prepared for the experience we've put together some information for you to review below.

### **WHAT YOU NEED TO DO BEFORE THE SESSION:**

- Each rider and passenger are required to purchase a wristband for each time they wish to participate. Remember, general admission is sold separately and touring will stop selling 45 minutes prior to start time.
- At the Touring Paddock prior to the start of each session, each individual must sign an insurance waiver releasing Road America from any liability and attend a mandatory riders meeting.
- Remember, minors must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian to sign the parental consent waiver.
- Arrive at Touring Paddock 45 minutes prior to scheduled start time. (Verify the daily schedule, all schedules are subject to change.)
- Scooters are not allowed in touring session.

### **WHERE YOU NEED TO GO:**

- Once inside the property, follow the access road to the **Touring Paddock** (located south of the start/finish line, adjacent to the main straightway)—see map on reverse.
- Note: Your wristband must be secured to your wrist prior to arriving at the Touring Paddock. And make sure to hold your hand aloft to show the guard your wristband for access to the Touring Paddock.

### **IMPORTANT ON TRACK INSTRUCTIONS:**

- Helmets are strongly recommended for rider and passenger.
- Each person on the motorcycle must follow all public traffic safety laws.
- Make certain that your motorcycle has enough gas.
- For obvious safety reasons, each "Touring Session" will be run at a speed of approximately 45 mph.
- Motorcycles will enter the track from the Touring Paddock following a Road America pace car with other pace cars interspersed within the group.
- NO PASSING of other bikes or the Road America pace cars will be allowed. All riders will be expected to operate their bikes in a responsible manner. Any driver deemed a danger to themselves or others will be removed from the track immediately.
