



RAKC Awards Ceremony / Victory Lap

To ensure you are prepared for the experience we've put together some information for you to review below.

WHAT YOU NEED:

- Each individual must sign an insurance waiver releasing Road America from any liability. (This will be done at the Track)
- Minors must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian to sign the parental consent waiver. (This will be done at the Track)
- No vehicle 8 ½ feet in height or taller will be allowed on track. (No Karts, Sorry...) 😊
- Please make sure your vehicle has at least ½ tank of gas when arriving for Victory Lap.
- Be sure to remember to bring your cameras!

WHERE TO BE:

- Enter Gate 6 (located off Hwy 67, at the north end of the track).
- Gate 6 opens at 9:30am. Feel free to show up around 15 minutes before scheduled time block.
- You will then be directed to a parking area near Victory Lane for the Awards Presentation.
- Awards will begin promptly at:
 - 10am – **KID KART** (KID KART CLASS ONLY – RACE HALF THE SEASON AND RECEIVE AN AWARD) & **BRIGGS 206 SPORTSMAN** classes
 - 10:30am – **BRIGGS 206 JR & BRIGGS 206 SR** classes
 - 11am – **WORLD FORMULA & KOHLER SUPER STOCK** classes
 - 11:30am – **YAHABA HEAVY, IAME KA 100 SR & JR, and TAG** classes
- Following the Awards Presentation.
 - After each time block, a guided 1 lap **Victory Lap** will occur at a slow pace!
 - Everyone participating in this event is encouraged to partake in the **Victory Lap**.
 - Paddock shop will be open from 10am till 1pm

ON-TRACK INSTRUCTIONS:

- Each person in the vehicle must wear a seat belt and all children must be properly restrained in child safety seats. All public traffic safety laws will be observed.
- There is no switching of drivers or passengers during the event.
- For obvious safety reasons, each event will be run at a slow guided speed of approximately 35 mph.
- Vehicles will enter the track following a Road America pace car with other pace cars interspersed within the group.

- NO PASSING of other vehicles or the Road America pace cars will be allowed. All drivers will be expected to operate their vehicles in a responsible manner. Any driver deemed a danger to themselves or others will be removed from the track immediately.
