Camping Requirements

To camp at Road America, each person age 17 and older must purchase:

- An Advanced Camping Wristband
- A valid Event Ticket
- A Camping Site

Guests age 16 and under must be accompanied by a paying adult and provide photo ID.
Each campsite allows up to six people. At least one must be age 18 or older.

Campsite Information

Standard sites are approximately 20 x 40 feet. Site features vary.
Please review camping descriptions on the Road America website before arrival.

Registration

All campers must check in at the designated registration area for their event.
Bring your camping wristband, event ticket, and campsite information.

If registration is missed during posted hours, entry will not be allowed until 7:00 AM the following day.
After registration, a wristband provides 24 hour access.
After 8:00 PM, entry is through Gate 6 only.
Camping duration varies by event. Campers may remain on site until noon on Monday after public events.

Occupying Your Site

Vehicles must fit completely within your campsite.
Overflow vehicles must park in designated non camping grass areas.

Only sleeping tents and small screen tents are permitted.
Large party tents are not allowed.
Do not drive stakes or attach items to asphalt, trees, fencing, poles, or buildings.
Do not tamper with electrical outlets.

Amenities

Water hookups are not available.
Electrical sites are located on the front straight. Bring at least 35 feet of cord and a 50 amp adapter.
Generators are allowed from 7:00 AM to 10:00 PM only.

Restrooms and showers are available throughout the property at no charge.
Concession stands and the Paddock Shop are available during most events.
Picnic tables are shared and may not be moved.
Please place garbage at the end of your campsite for collection.
Dispose of ashes only in designated containers.



Pets

Pets must be leashed or secured in vehicles with proper ventilation and water.
Clean up after your pet.
Pets are not allowed in paddock areas during spectator events.
Disruptive or exotic pets may be restricted.
Incidents involving pets may result in removal without refund.

Dump Stations

Gray water must be disposed of at designated dump stations or campground toilets.
Dishwashing is not allowed in restroom sinks.
Dump stations are located at Carousel Campground and inside Gate 6.

Campfires and Environment

Open ground fires are not allowed.
Fires must be contained in raised grills or portable fire pits.

Road America is home to protected wildlife and plant species.
Please respect the environment. Take only what you bring.

Quiet Time

Quiet hours are enforced from 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM.
Radios are not allowed after 10:00 PM.
Professional sound systems and loud music are prohibited at all times.
No vehicle movement after 10:00 PM until sunrise except for entry, exit, or restroom access.
Observe a 5 MPH speed limit at all times.

Prohibited Items and Behavior

Firearms, fireworks, and disorderly conduct are strictly prohibited.
Abusive language or disruptive behavior will result in removal.

Transportation and Vehicles

All vehicles may be subject to search upon entry.
Vehicles must be street licensed and operated by a valid driver.
Vehicles driven after dark must have operable headlights and taillights.
Unlicensed vehicles, such as personal golf carts, UTVs/ATVs, motorized furniture, homemade, stand up scooters without an OEM manufactured seat, Low Speed Vehicles (LSVs) and similar vehicles are not allowed.
Bicycles are permitted in spectator areas and require a operable headlight and taillight visible at 250', if operated after sunset.
Skateboards, hoverboards, single wheeled, and roller devices are prohibited.
Shuttle service is available during public events.
Public transportation is not available to the facility.
Anyone under 18 years of age is highly recommended to wear a helmet while operating any two-wheeled motorized vehicle, licensed or unlicensed, while on perimeter roads.
