



Street Legal Drags Competitor Information

Don't take things too seriously - Just relax and have fun!

Tires

- Slick or DOT Street Slick Tires Are Only Allowed In Group 1 "Open Class." All other classes must run DOT street legal tires.

Drag Racing Participants

- NO BURNOUTS
- Entrants will run against similar vehicles on a 330 Ft (1/16th mile) running in separate lanes.
- Tech Officials determine your Bracket prior to entering pits. If you have questions, contact them. They are located in the staging area.
- Additional brackets may be added. Note that you may be moved up a Bracket if we determine your vehicle does not meet the parameters of the current Bracket you are competing in. Be honest with the Tech Officials about what you have done to your vehicle.
- Passengers welcome (must be over 12 years old). Two-door vehicles are allowed a maximum of two people in the vehicle. Four-door vehicles are allowed a maximum of four people in the vehicle.
- No limit on practice/grudge runs (as time permits). Just pull up to the line and we will release you one car at a time. You may get in line in the pre-staging area.
- No speeding after drag runs. SLOW DOWN
- If we have determined you have "red-lighted" you will be notified in the return lane.
- You may enter in more than one bracket (\$10 each). Once you win the bracket, we ask that you do not participate in that bracket at the next event. (Except for the open brackets).
- When bracket racing begins, we will separate you into your bracket. Brackets are double elimination and may combine brackets depending on the number of vehicles entered. Brackets are run in a respective order as well.
- After each bracket run, you must stop in the designated stop area. The stop area will have proper signage that lets you know where to stop. Once you have come to a stop, an official will guide you where to go. You must go into the pits if you are eliminated from your bracket. We may split (break out) a bracket if have a large number of cars or have performance differences.
- Motorcycles are required to wear helmets, long-sleeved clothing, long pants, and closed-toe shoes/boots.
- Be aware that we will not tolerate stupidity during racing or at any other time. This is about having fun. Relax and enjoy the camaraderie.
- No buybacks

Safety First

- Road America provides a controlled, professionally managed racing environment. Unsafe or wreckless behavior will result in removal from the event.

Spectators

- \$15 per spectator. Kids 16 and under are FREE.
- When viewing the races, bring a blanket or lawn chair. We also have bleachers and a VIP patio to take in the sights and sounds.
- Please be aware of your safety at all times.
- Alcohol is not permitted in the staging areas.
- You will park in the grass areas around the race track if you are not racing.
- Please drive slowly when entering/exiting Road America, as children may be in this area.
