

Thank you for registering to participate in the sunset cruise. To ensure you are prepared for the experience we've put together some information for you to review below.

WHAT YOU NEED:

- Each vehicle will need to display the sunset cruise pass in the lower windshield area of the driver's side of the vehicle.
- Each individual must sign an insurance waiver releasing Road America from any liability.
- Minors must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian to sign the parental consent waiver.
- No vehicle 6 ½ feet in height or taller will be allowed on track.
- Please make sure your vehicle has at least ½ tank of gas when arriving.
- Be sure to remember to bring your cameras!

WHERE TO BE:

- Enter Gate 6 (located off Hwy 67, at the north end of the track) no earlier than 5pm and no later than 5:40pm.
- You will then be directed to the paddock area to park.
- A mandatory meeting will begin promptly at 5:40pm in the staging area.

ON-TRACK INSTRUCTIONS:

- Each person in the vehicle must wear a seat belt and all children must be properly restrained in child safety seats. All public traffic safety laws will be observed.
- There is no switching of drivers or passengers during the event.
- For obvious safety reasons, each event will be run at a slow guided speed of approximately 35 mph.
- Vehicles will enter the track following a Road America pace car with other pace cars interspersed within the group.
- NO PASSING of other vehicles or the Road America pace cars will be allowed. All drivers will be expected to operate their vehicles in a responsible manner. Any driver deemed a danger to themselves or others will be removed from the track immediately.
