Established in 1955, Road America is located midway between Milwaukee and Green Bay in Elkhart Lake, Wisconsin. Its legendary four-mile, 14-turn road circuit has challenged the world's best racers for over 60 years. The 640-acre, park-like grounds offer amazing viewing opportunities, fantastic concessions, and high-speed excitement to thousands of spectators each year. In addition to public race weekends, Road America offers group adventure programs, karting and supermoto at the CTECH Motorplex, and the Road America Motorcycle and Driving Schools.

ROAD AMERICA FAST FACTS

- 1) RA stock was first offered and sold in 1954 with ground breaking for Road America in April of 1955. The first race took place in September of 1955.
- 2) Road America was founded by **Mr. Clif Tufte**, an engineer by training. Clif is known historically as "Mr. Road America" and is credited with the dream & vision of the original configuration including current site of the circuit & complex today.
- 3) Road America is a corporation with 500 plus stockholders and is guided by a 12 member board of directors. RA employs over 20 full time staff. The seasonal payroll swells to over 500 during the height of racing season June thru August.
- 4) An independent economic impact survey was commissioned in 2015 by Road America and performed by Lakeland College. Findings of this study show an annual conservative first tier economic impact of Road America for Sheboygan County and State of Wisconsin to be approximately \$74 million dollars per year direct impact to the region.
- 5) Road America is one of the fastest permanent road racing circuits in the world. Road America is 4.048 miles in length with 14 turns and multiple elevation changes. Road America is situated on 640 natural acres of rolling hills in Wisconsin's Kettle Moraine and is known as "America's National Park of Speed™.
- 6) Each year, Road America entertains over 800,000 visitors in addition to competitors at its site in Sheboygan County, April through October and hosts over 500 events a year with 9 major televised races.
- 7) Since being founded, Road America has helped hundreds of local and Midwest charities through monetary donations, in-kind goods / services and on-site fundraising opportunities. For example, between 1981 and 2017 the Road America walk/run event generated over \$3 million dollars for the American Cancer Society!
- 8) 2016 marked the return of open-wheel IndyCars to Road America after a 9 year absence. 100,000 people attended on-site with another million plus watching the event on television.
- 9) Road America continues to add new and exciting offerings such as: 4 Miles of Fitness Events at Road America, a 18-hole disc golf course, and 4-Mile Dinner Series.

- 11) Road America's Mission: To develop a year-round facility and programs which provide the best motorsport and entertainment experience for all our customers.


