Car Corral

We welcome you to join us at the Car Corral at Road America. When you arrive at the track, you will enter through the MAIN GATE, where your digital ticket will be scanned, and you will receive your Car Corral windshield pass. Please note that if you have anyone riding in your car, they must purchase a General Admission ticket to access the track and join you on the parade laps. Kids 16 and under enter for free.

Once you collect your Car Corral pass, you will take a right from the main gate to proceed to the intersection for the tunnel, where you will take a left to go under the track in the tunnel. With the Car Corral pass on their windshield, you will be directed under the tunnel to proceed to the Car Corral, located by the Podium (see the map below for reference)

Upon arrival at the car corral, you will see an SRO Tent where you will be greeted and shown where to park. After you park, return to the SRO Tent to register for the parade lap on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, taking place at the end of the day.

You'll be walking distance from the fan zone and main paddock, where you have full access to roam and see all the amazing GT machinery. Be sure to check out our fan zone & some of our activations -Don't forget to snag an EBOOST for extra energy!

Friday, August 15th

Registration: When you arrive, register under the SRO tent. Please have your driver's license and valid insurance.

Registration will close 15 minutes before the driver's meeting starts.

Parade Lap: 6:00 pm *Weather Permitting

Saturday, August 16th

Registration: When you arrive, register under the SRO tent. Please have your driver's license and valid insurance.

Drivers Meeting MANDATORY: Will start at 5:30 pm *sharp at the SRO tent

Parade Lap: 6:00 pm *Weather Permitting

Sunday, August 17th

Registration: When you arrive, register under the SRO tent. Please have your driver's license and valid insurance.

Registration will close 15 minutes before the driver's meeting starts.

Drivers Meeting MANDATORY: Will start at 3:45 pm *sharp at the SRO tent

Parade Lap: 4:15 pm *Weather Permitting

Traffic in and out of the Car Corral & Track

You will need to sign two waivers in order to be eligible for parade laps. You can now fill out the SRO waiver, and it will be saved on your phone as a text to make your registration process smoother. Once you come to register for the parade lap at the SRO tent, you will sign Road America waiver. Please visit THIS LINK to complete the SRO waiver.

Traffic in and out of the car corral will be limited throughout the event. After the drivers meeting, we will depart in order as instructed by the SRO staff member. Anyone inside the car MUST sign waivers and show bracelets when entering the track.

Damages to Road America Property

Anyone who causes damage to Road America property, including track, equipment, buildings, vehicles, fences, safety systems, grass, and landscaped areas, will be held responsible for all costs relating to replacement or repair.

































Car Corral Pass

Your Car Corral pass includes entry for the driver, designated parking, and eligibility for the Parade Laps (Fri, Sat, & Sun). Please note that if you have anyone riding in your car, they must purchase a General Admission ticket to access the track and join you on the parade laps. —Kids 16 and under enter for free.

When you arrive at the track, you will enter through the MAIN GATE, where your digital ticket will be scanned, and you will receive your Car Corral windshield pass.









































Parade Lap Guidelines

Please be on time for the mandatory Drivers Meeting. You will NOT be able to participate without attending. A helmet is not necessary for the Parade Lap.

DO

- Follow the Lead Car: A pace car will lead the parade, and it's crucial that you maintain a safe distance from the vehicle in front of you.
- Keep a Steady Pace: While we encourage you to enjoy the experience, it's important to maintain a steady and consistent pace. Sudden acceleration or deceleration can create unsafe conditions for other drivers.
- Use Your Signals: When entering or exiting the track, be sure to use your turn signals to communicate your intentions clearly to other drivers.
- Windows Down.

DON'T

- **No Passing:** This is a parade, NOT a race. Passing other vehicles is strictly prohibited.
- No Burnouts or Excessive Revving: While we understand the temptation, burnouts & excessive revving can damage the track surface.
- No Stopping on Track: Unless instructed by a course marshal or in case of an emergency, do not stop your vehicle on the track. This can create a hazardous situation for other drivers.
- No Alcohol or Substance Use: Driving under the influence of alcohol or any other substance is strictly prohibited.
- No Distractions: Keep your focus on the road and avoid any distractions, such as using your phone or engaging in other activities while driving.
- No Rubber Banding.
- No minors are allowed to drive. 18 and up.
